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This book presents statistical models that have recently been developed within several research communities to access information contained in text collections. In order to give the reader as complete a description as possible, the focus is placed on the probability models used in the applications concerned, by highlighting the relationship between models and applications and by illustrating the behavior of each model on real collections.
